## Events and News for January - April of 2011



Our first team for 2011 arrived on January 15th. [First Baptist Church Brinkley Arkansas](#) has been working in Southern Belize since the mid-80's. The past two years, they have worked in the Village of Santa Rosa to build a Sunday school building for the Baptist Church there. The ladies in the group also did daily Bible study with the ladies in the Villages of Santa Rosa and San Roman.



Our home church, [Riverside Baptist](#) arrived in March. As always, they partnered with our church, Silk Grass Baptist. This year the project was to begin construction on an Education Center. They began the work on the foundation and we hope to get other teams to help with pouring the foundation and laying the block. Riverside will plan to pour the roof on the building when they return next March.



[Woodcrest Christian High School](#) returned to work in Southern Belize for the second year. This year they brought two groups. One group returned to work with Pomona Christian Community Church and another group began a partnership with Bella Vista Baptist Church. This team provides ministry through VBS, sports, drama, music and community projects. Each group also did work on the church such as tiling the floor.



The [First Baptist Church Forest City, NC](#) returned this year. They came the first time back in 2008 and worked in the Village of Trio. This year they worked in the Village of San Juan. They arrived the day before Easter so they attended Sunrise service at the Baptist Church in San Juan and then did an Easter egg hunt for the children. The group did a daily Sports camp for the Youth and VBS for the children.

We now begin the busiest time of year as we will have teams arriving on the same day that the previous team departs. God has truly blessed us here in Southern Belize through the many teams willing to partner with us to minister to the local people and to bring resources for the Villages and the Churches. The last team for 2011 is scheduled for October. We will then take a few weeks to travel home to Alabama. Our plan is to be home for the Thanksgiving Holiday this year.
